To get full academic year salary amount: Add semester 1 and semester 2 amounts together.

Non-Resident Tuition Waivers: Position must be 1/3 time or more & subject to availability of funds

Minimum credit load for all assistantships is 6 credits per semester

To find FTE used, divide dollars of assistantship by base rate

How to figure a Graduate Assistant Summer Session Payment:

$\$20,515$ (Academic Salary) / 32 (weeks in AY) - Weekly Rate

Weekly Rate / 5 (days in week) = Daily Rate

Daily Rate * % working * number of weekdays in contract = Summer Session Payment
